3. The Applicant must complete the entire application process, including but not limited to, the submission of letters of recommendation, a typed personal statement, most recent/current **OFFICIAL** High School Transcript and complete the required interview upon notification. Incomplete applications will not be considered. The Scholarship Committee will not reach out to applicants to obtain missing information.
