1. Applications **MUST** be completed and submitted in its entirety via email to no later than **MONDAY MARCH 6, 2023, by 11:59 PM**. incomplete applications will not be considered.
2. Applications will not be accepted on behalf of others. Student's must provide their direct contact information: name, address, contact email and phone number. Students are expected to correspond directly with the scholarship committee.
3. Students **MUST** be sponsored by a financial 2023 NOBLE member.
4. Sponsors **MUST review, sign, and include their membership number** on the student's scholarship applications before submission of application.
5. Finalists **MUST** attend interview with NOBLE Panel for consideration. Dress code is business attire or corporate dress: **no jeans, sneakers, baggy jeans/pants, hats, etc.** Please contact us at [scholarship@noblenewyork.org](mailto:scholarship@noblenewyork.org) if you have any questions about appropriate business attire.
6. To qualify for the New York Law Enforcement Foundation Scholarship (NYLEF), student's parent/legal guardian must be an **active member of NYPD**, this scholarship will require a separate application upon award. NYLEF check's will be mailed directly to the student's school of attendance.
7. Scholarship winners must provide a bursar's receipt or letter with official stamp demonstrating attendance at qualifying institution by 9/01/2023 to receive payment. Receipts must be delivered electronically by e-mail to [scholarship@noblenewyork.org](mailto:scholarship@noblenewyork.org).
