5. Applicant must not be related to member of the committee

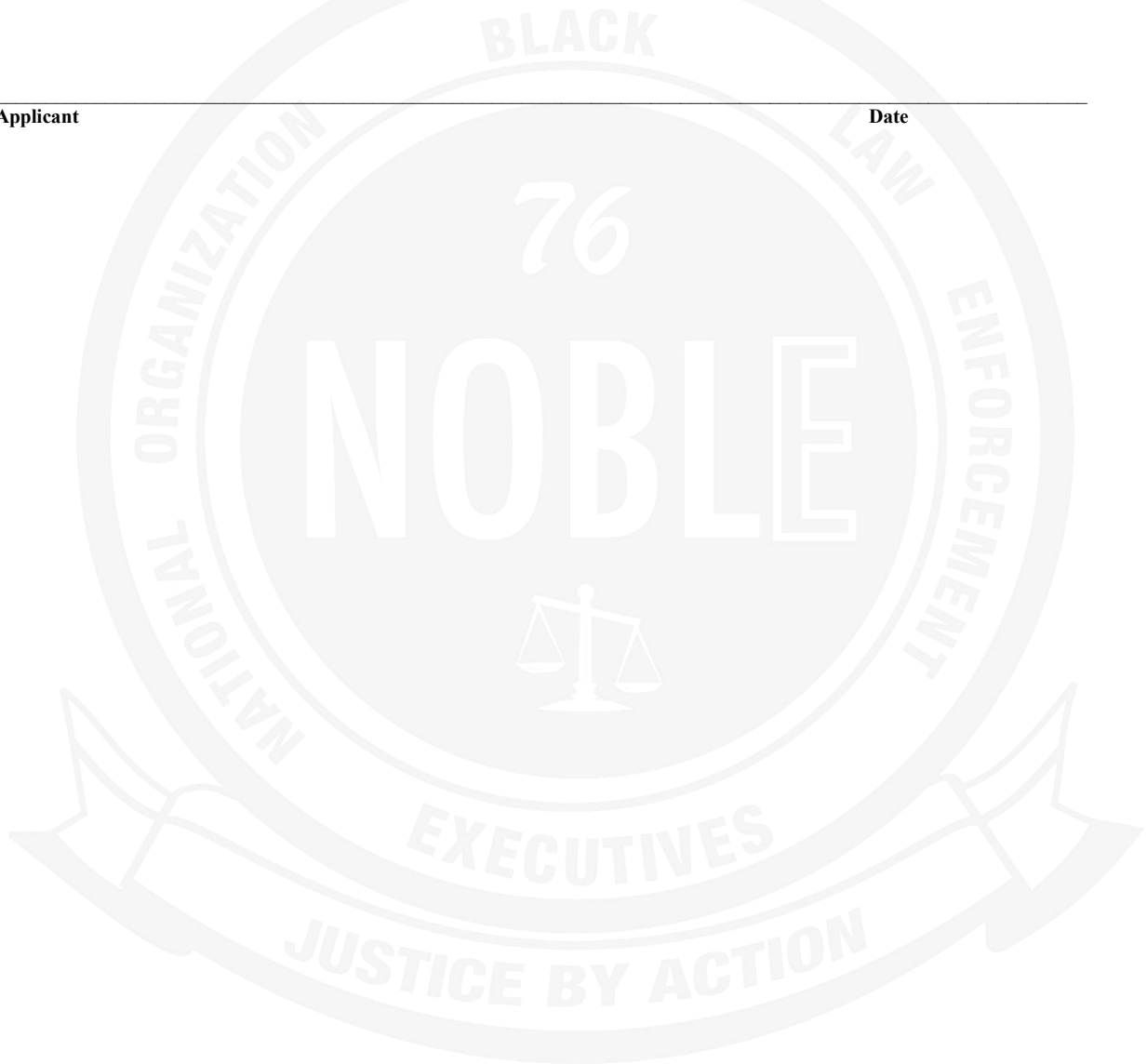
