- One (1)** Letter of Recommendation from **ONE** of the following:
 - Academic Advisor
 - Current or Former Teacher
 - Faith-Based Organization member or leader
 - Community Group member or leader
 - Civic Association member or leader
- Current Official School Transcript

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must be a High School Senior in New York State, in the graduating class of 2024 and expected to receive a High School Diploma or a New York State High School Equivalency/TASC Diploma (Formerly known as the GED).
- Students **MUST** be sponsored by a **financial 2024 NOBLE member**. Sponsors **MUST** review, sign, and include their membership number on the student’s scholarship application **BEFORE** submission of the application.
- To qualify for the New York Law Enforcement Foundation Scholarship (NYLEF), student’s parent/legal guardian must be an active member of NYPD, this scholarship will require a separate application upon award. NYLEF checklist will be mailed directly to the student’s school of attendance.
- Students must provide their direct contact information: full name, address, email address, and phone number. Students are expected to correspond directly with the scholarship committee.
- Finalists **MUST** attend an interview with NOBLE Panel for consideration. The dress code is business attire or corporate dress: no jeans, sneakers, baggy jeans/pants, hats, etc. Please
